The Berta Breakfast Program serves Berta pancakes every morning before school to over 225 children. Berta is designed specifically for malnourished children; a nutritious, wheat-based product enriched with vitamins & minerals. Most families in Korah only eat 1 - 2 times per day and the quality of food is often extremely poor. Berta changes lives!
